



TERMS AND CONDITIONS

MATERIALS: Scribble Health activities, include but are not exclusive to paints, glues, pastels, chalk pastels, pencils, plastic, felt markers, wire, foil, air dry and oven bake clay etc. Scribble Health takes all possible precautions to reduce risk and provide safe, healthy, and enjoyable experiences.

PERMISSION TO PHOTOGRAPH: Enrolment in a workshop indicates the consent for Cheryl Oliver to photograph artworks of students participating, to be used in promotional material. Please ensure that if you do not agree to this you make it known prior to the workshop. All care will be taken to NOT photograph your child, only the artwork. However, if you would like to give permission for your child to be photographed, you can fill out a written consent form.

MEDICAL NEEDS OF CHILDREN: Please make it known if your child has any specific medical needs, in particular food allergies. Children with food allergies are required to bring their own EpiPen and please ensure that I am aware of the allergy. If your child will require medication during the workshop, please ensure that the medication is in a labelled zip-lock bag (child's name, medication name and administering instructions)

PERMISSION TO LEAVE: Scribble Health will not authorise a child to leave the studio with anyone other than a parent or an organised care giver that has been organised prior to collection

PAYMENTS: All payments can be made online at www.scribblehealth.com.au and prepayment of group and individual sessions is required before your appointment or group program begins.

CANCELLATIONS: Should Scribble Health need to cancel a workshop or program for any reason, you will be advised of a replacement session. If there is no replacement session, you will be issued with a refund.

Cancellations of Individual Art Therapy/Counselling Sessions: Refunds will not be given for cancellations on behalf of the attendee for change of mind or personal circumstances. Refunds will be considered on applications submitted two days prior to an appointment. *Please give 2 days' notice if unable to attend a booked individual appointment so I can reschedule your session.

Group Programs: Refunds will not be given for absences during group programs at Kids Point or Noraville Studio.

Refunds cannot be given for Creative Kids Government Vouchers.
