We have zero tolerance for abuse and any/all allegations and safety concerns will be treated seriously and consistently according to our Code of Ethics ( Australian Counselling Association Member-Code Of Ethics)

We follow legal and moral obligations to contact authorities when concerned about a child's safety, which we follow rigorously.

Scribble Health is committed to regular training and education on child abuse risks (NSW Government requirements for School Teachers) as well as maintaining WWCC.

At Scribble Health we respect all children. We are committed to the cultural safety of Aboriginal children, the cultural safety of children from a culturally and/or linguistically diverse backgrounds, and to providing a safe environment for children with a disability.

By promoting diversity and tolerance at Scribble Health we ensure that all children are safe and can participate equally.
